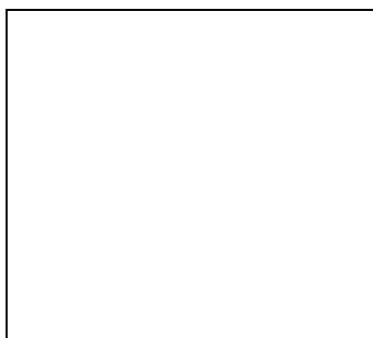


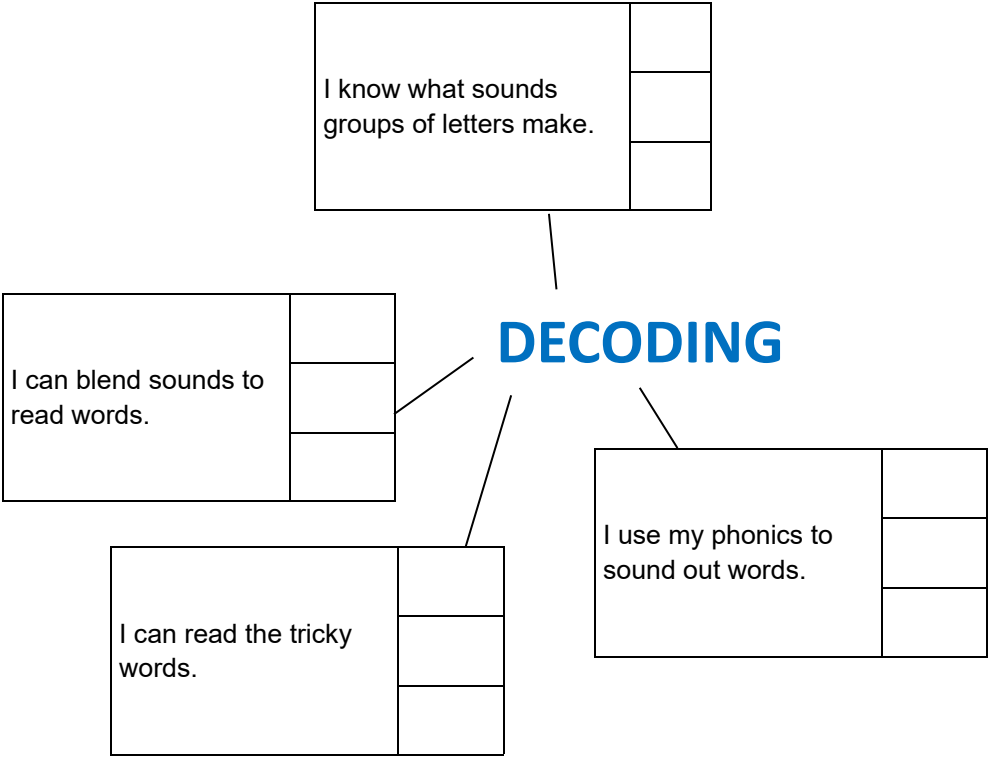

SPAG DEFINITIONS

Letter— a symbol. We use letters to make words.

Capital letter— a big form of the letter, used to show the start of the sentence or the name of a person or place.

Word— a group of letters that means something.

Singular— one of something.

Plural— more than one of something.

Sentence— a group of words that means something and makes sense when you put them together. A sentence must have a verb.

Punctuation— marks used to help make the meaning clear in sentences.

Full stop— a dot that shows where a sentence ends.

Question mark— a punctuation mark - ? - that goes at the end of a question.
