

STATISTICS

I can find information in different graphs.

I can show equivalent fractions E.g. $1/2 = 2/4$	

I can count up and down in hundredths (e.g. $24/100, 25/100$)	

FRACTIONS & DECIMALS

I can recognise hundredths when dividing.	

I can round decimals to the nearest whole number .	

I can use decimals when solving measure and money problems E.g. £2.34, 1.79m	

MEASUREMENT

I can compare and sort triangles and quadrilaterals.	

I can convert units of measure E.g. $2.34\text{m} = 234\text{cm}$.	

GEOMETRY

I can identify symmetry in 2D shapes.	

I can accurately draw missing sides of 2D shapes.	

SPAG DEFINITIONS

Determiner— A determiner specifies a noun as known or unknown, and it goes before any modifiers (e.g. adjectives or other nouns). Some examples of determiners are: articles (the, a or an), demonstratives (e.g. this, those), possessives (e.g. my, your), and quantifiers (e.g. some, every).

Pronoun— a word used to replace a noun e.g. The woman waved to John / She waved to him.

Possessive pronoun— a pronoun that shows possession e.g. That book is mine. His book is over there.

Adverbial— a word or phrase that is used like an adverb to give you more information about the verb e.g. I had chips last night. We ate them in the car.
