

Pupil Premium Expenditure 2013/14

In 2011 the Government introduced Pupil Premium Funding. This additional funding is aimed at children receiving free school meals. As schools know their children, the Government let individual schools decide how the additional funding will be best spent to support the learning of children entitled to free school meals.

Additional activities that we have been able to provide in school with the pupil premium funding this year for your children are:

Area	Cost	Description
Y6 One to One and Small Group Tuition.	£21,268	This intervention will give pupils the opportunity to work in a small group or on a one to one basis with a teacher. These sessions are planned to fill gaps and address misconceptions in learning.
Year Six Booster sessions.	£1793.88	Small group sessions with a teacher. These sessions are planned to fill gaps in learning as children prepare for the end
Early intervention. Speech, language and communication.	£20,000	Pupils who have speech, language and communication needs should be helped as soon as possible. This work is providing pupils with vital early intervention to support, speech, language and communication development.
One to One and small group tuition for lower KS2 Reading Writing and Maths.	£20,000	This intervention will give pupils the opportunity to work in a small group or on a one to one basis with a teacher. These sessions are planned to fill gaps and address misconceptions in learning.
Mobile Interactive White-	£5000	Enhance teaching and learning during
Positive Play.	£2805.44	This intervention will help to develop pupils confidence, self-esteem and social skills in a secure and caring environment.
Nurture.	£6079.32	This intervention will be aimed at pupils who struggle to work and play in group situations. This small group with skilled members of staff supports pupils development of social skills and self-esteem.
